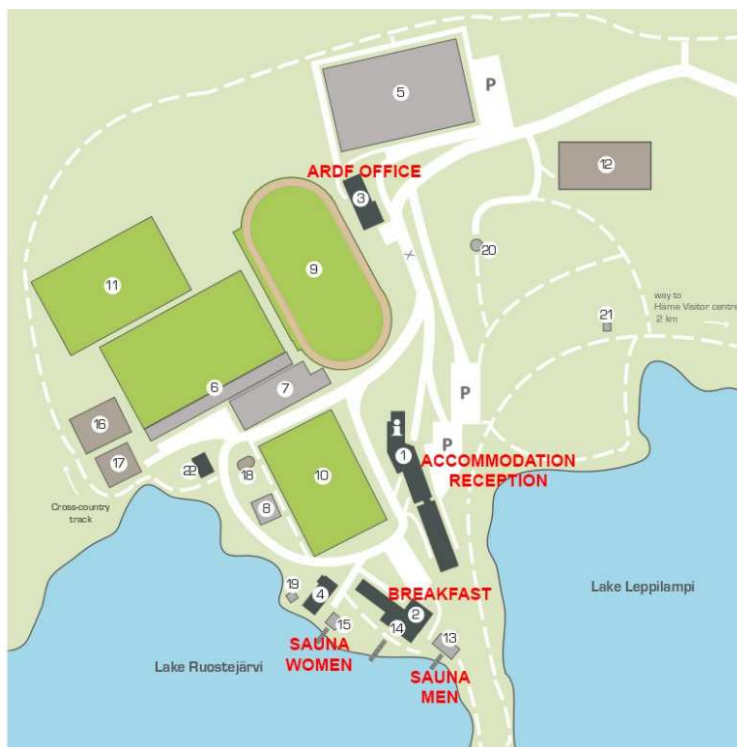


### Note!
